### **Commissioner Comments:**

- 3 stores still closed due to the flood Johnson, Montpelier, Londonderry
- Sales not substantially impacted by the flood
- Lottery sales up 18% weekending 9/2
- Liquor sales up 3% weekending 9/2
- B2B Website we have a contract and are working on internal reviews. Possible launch in 10 months



- o Making progress with lottery kiosk, Sci games is working to resolve technical issues
- Megabucks is going to a 3 draws per week, Monday Wednesday Saturday starting this week.

#### Other Business:

- o Action Item: Lost Lantern Proposal
  - o As an Independent Bottler.
  - Three questions were proposed. The board's decision is that Lost Lantern would be able to sell Lost Lantern branded product bottled by another VT manufacturer Lost Lantern's 4<sup>th</sup> class licensed establishment but not during a special event or through 802Spirits stores.
  - The Lost Lantern branded products bottled out of state cannot be imported or sold in Vermont.
  - Bulk importation of spirits is permissible for all VT manufacturers as long as the following conditions are met: the manufacturer is licensed in VT; they follow all federal laws and regulations; all shipments include a bill of lading including originating and receiving manufacturer, total quantity, and the ABV/Proof of the products being shipped.
  - o Motion Thom Lauzon with ratify second Ed Flanagan unanimously.
