SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Department of Liquor Control ("DLC") notified Scott Reed d/b/a Hide-Away Tavern ("Licensee") to appear for a February 8, 2017 contested case hearing wherein the Liquor Control Board ("Board") would consider sanctions against the Licensee's First and Third Class Liquor Licenses. Licensee has reached an agreement with DLC. The Board has agreed to accept the following resolution and impose the agreed-upon sanction as follows:

LICENSEE SHALL ADMIT ONE (1) VIOLATION OF GENERAL REGULATION NO. 17 WHICH OCCURRED ON DECEMBER 9, 2016 AND, ACCORDINGLY, ITS FIRST AND THIRD-CLASS LIQUOR LICENSES SHALL BE SUSPENDED FOR SEVEN (7) DAYS:

FROM THE OPENING OF BUSINESS ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2017 TO THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2017.

Licensee acknowledges and agrees that, at all times and in all communications and proceedings related to this matter and to this Agreement, it has had the right to be represented and advised by legal counsel. Licensee has carefully reviewed and considered this Agreement. Licensee agrees and understands that, by executing this Agreement, it is waiving any right to a hearing related to the matter before the Board on February 8, 2017 (thereby waiving any right to be presented with the evidence against it, to cross-examine adverse witnesses, and to offer evidence of its own to contest the DLC's allegation(s)) and waiving any right to challenge the jurisdiction and continuing jurisdiction of the Board in this matter. See 7 V.S.A. § 236; 3 V.S.A. §§ 809, 814.
