ORDER CONDITIONALLY GRANTING SECOND CLASS LIQUOR LICENSE

The Liquor Control Board (“Board”) held proceedings on October 11, 2017 in Montpelier to consider RGS Napali Market, LLC’s (“Applicant”) Second-Class Liquor License Application (the “Application”). Jacob A. Humbert, Esq., Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Vermont Department of Liquor Control (“DLC”). Ratna Khadka and Goma Khadka, owners, appeared on behalf of the Applicant.

Upon consideration of the testimony presented, the Board decided to grant the Application and issue a Second-Class Liquor License subject to the conditions that (1) Ratna Khadka, Goma Khadka and any other owner, member or employee that may sell beverage alcohol at or from the licensed premises attend and complete *in-person* DLC training to DLC’s satisfaction; and (2) that Ratna Khadka and Goma Khadka satisfy DLC that they are in good standing with the Vermont Department of Taxes, both individually and with respect to any Vermont businesses they own.
