ORDER CONDITIONALLY GRANTING FIRST CLASS LIQUOR LICENSE

The Liquor Control Board (“Board”) held proceedings on October 11, 2017 in Montpelier to consider Wicked Awesome BBQ’s (“Applicant”) First-Class Liquor License Application (the “Application”). Jacob A. Humbert, Esq., Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Vermont Department of Liquor Control (“DLC”). David E. McInnis, owner, appeared on behalf of the Applicant.

Upon consideration of the testimony offered and evidence presented, the Board will grant the Application and issue a First-Class Liquor License subject to the conditions that (1) neither Mr. McInnis nor any employee of Applicant possess, consume and/or be under the influence of marijuana (in any form) or possess, consume and/or be under the influence of any illegal drug at any time while on the licensed premises; (2) Mr. McInnis shall notify DLC by 4:00 p.m. on the next business day following any charge of any criminal offense against him in any jurisdiction; (3) the license is granted subject to Board review should the Board learn of information that might bear on the veracity of the testimony offered and evidence received on October 11, 2017; and (4) the license is granted until the end of the current licensing period (April 30, 2018) and no renewal will be granted without a hearing; DLC is directed to set any renewal application for hearing at a regularly scheduled Board meeting to be held in April 2018. Conditions 1 and 2 shall be permanent.
