ORDER GRANTING MANUFACTURING LICENSE RENEWAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS

The Liquor Control Board ("Board") held proceedings on April 11, 2018 in Montpelier to

consider Upper Pass Beer Co.'s ("Applicant") Manufacturing License Application (the "Application").

Jacob A. Humbert, Esq., Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Vermont Department of

Liquor Control (DLC). Andrew Puchalik, owner, appeared on behalf of the Applicant.

Upon consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, the Board decided unanimously to

grant the Application subject to the conditions that (1) Mr. Puchalik and/or any other owner of Licensee

shall not be charged with any alcohol-related offense; and (2) if Mr. Puchalik and/or any other owner of

Licensee is charged with any alcohol-related offense, Licensee shall notify DLC by 4:00 p.m. on the

next business day following any such charge for any alcohol-related offense (regardless of the

jurisdiction in which the offense is charged).

The Board GRANTS the application for Manufacturing License renewal for the 2018-2019

period subject to conditions (1) and (2) remaining in effect until and unless lifted by the Board.
