ORDER GRANTING FIRST CLASS LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS

The Liquor Control Board (Board) held proceedings on October 11, 2017 in Montpelier to consider

Wicked Awesome BBQ's ("Applicant") First Class Liquor License Application (the "Application"). Jacob A.

Humbert, Esq., Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Vermont Department of Liquor Control

(DLC). David E. McInnis, owner, appeared on behalf of the Applicant.

Upon consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, the Board decided unanimously to grant the

Application subject to the conditions that (1) neither Mr. McInnis nor any employee possess, consume and/or be

under the influence of marijuana (in any form) or any illegal drug; (2) Mr. McInnis shall notify DLC by 4:00 p.m.

on next business day following any charge of any criminal offense against him in any jurisdiction; (3) this grant of

a licensee is subject to Board review should additional information regarding the testimony offered and evidence

received on October 11, 2014 become known to the Board which bears on the veracity of same; and (4) this

license is granted until the end of the current licensing period (April 30, 2018) and no renewal will be granted

without a hearing; DLC is directed to set any renewal application for hearing at a regularly scheduled Board

meeting in April 2018.

Having held the requisite hearing on April 11, 2018 in Montpelier and having heard testimony from Sgt.

Martin Prevost, DLC Director of Licensing, that all conditions of licensure have been met, the Board GRANTS

the application for First-Class Liquor License renewal for the 2018-2019 period subject to conditions (1) and (2)

remaining in effect unless and until lifted by the Board.
