Commissioner Update:

- Extended our lease of administrative office building for 3 years; still working with BGS for an RFP; at least 2 years before we move
- \$101 million liquor sales in FY24, down 1.85% lower from FY23
- June liquor sales down 6.4% compared to last year
- \$168 million in Lottery Sales for FY24, up 6%
- \$3.5 million in revenue share for sports wagering since launching in January (six months)
- FY25 start of new fiscal year
- Brought in about \$30,000 for spring spirits raffle
